Our Process

IT Landes' residential duct cleanings are usually completed in one day (per central heating/cooling duct system). Our duct cleaning technicians begin with an assessment of the duct layout. A large HEPA vacuum is connected to a central location of the supply air duct. When the vacuum is turned on, it provides suction to all supply ducts and vents/registers throughout the home. Starting at each

vent/register opening, the technicians use the "Hurricane Whip" system and high pressure air to loosen the debris and move duct contaminants into the main trunk line of the duct system.

The technicians then clean the main trunk line into the HEPA vacuum system by the same means. The supply duct is now clean, and the technicians repeat the same process to the return ducts.
